

Pork Festival announces additions, concert

EATON — Preble County Pork Festival organizers announced in July they are "bacon" some additions to this year's festival set for Saturday and Sunday, Sept. 21-22.

The Pork Festival Board of Directors is introducing bacon for the 53rd annual festival.

"The board of directors unanimously agreed that it was finally the right time to introduce bacon into their food offering line up for 2024 festival," organizers aid in a press release, noting they "will be 'bacon breakfast better."

The addition of bacon will only be available in the allyou-eat breakfast buffet which is open Saturday and Sunday, 6-10 a.m.

"Who doesn't love bacon?" board of directors president Zach Shafer, said in the release. "The board is very excited to be able to bring in an additional meat to better enhance festival-goers love for pork!"

Another addition is a con-

cert on Saturday evening.

"In addition to adding bacon to the 53rd annual festival, the board is elated to announce their addition of a new headlining concert this year," Shafer said in the release.

The concert will begin at 7 p.m. on Saturday, Sept, 21, with gates opening at 6 p.m. The headline concert will open with a local band, and will also feature American Idol Star Alexis Gomez and Jason Michael Carroll. Headlining the concert will be recording artist Easton Corbin.

"Corbin has been gracing stages with his memorable baritone and unique blend of traditional and modern country music for more than a decade," organizers said in the release.

"The entire board is so excited to be able to bring this unique enhancement to the festival this year," Shafer said. "We, have been reenergized this year with an enthusiasm unknown by most. The festival is solely under the direction of the board of directors which is refreshed and so excited for their 53rd festival. We have divided the workload, engaged all of the board membership and have the most amazing group of people working as one to pull of the 53rd edition of the Preble County Pork Festival."

• The U.S. pork industry represents a significant value-add to the agricultural economy and a major contributor to the overall U.S. economy. In 2021, more than 66,000 U.S. pork producers marketed 140+ million hogs valued at over \$28+ billion in gross cash receipts. The sales generated from hog marketings and pork processing support a total economic contribution of \$35-plus billion in personal income, \$57-plus billion in value added (GDP), and more than 610,000 jobs in the U.S. economy.

• The Ohio pork industry adds significant value to the agricultural economy and is a major contributor to the overall Ohio economy. Although the size and structure of the Ohio pork industry has changed over time, current levels of production continue to support jobs and generate earnings in the state economy. In 2021, the sales generated from hog marketings and pork processing supported a total economic contribution of over \$878.532 million in personal income, over \$1.370 billion in value added, and more than 16,743 jobs in the Ohio economy.

• There are about 2.75 million hogs in Ohio. The size of the Ohio hog herd has varied over time but has trended upward from 1.49M head in 2000 to 2.75M head in 2021. As of December 2021, Ohio farms accounted for 3.7 percent of the total U.S. hog inventory.

• The number of Ohio hog farms has decreased slightly in recent years. From 1997 to 2012, the number of farms decreased from 6,637 to 3,494, and by 2017 Ohio had 3,484 farms raising hogs.

Approximately 47 percent of Ohio hogs are on farms with 5,000 or more in inventory. 42 percent of Ohio's hogs are on farms with 2,000 to 4,999 head, and 11 percent are on farms

with less than 2,000 head.

• In 2021, hog sales (including market hogs, sows, and feeder pigs) totaled \$933.1 million. In addition to these farm-level effects, the pork industry supports other industries by purchasing inputs, supplies, and services. Based on long-run prices and aggregated production budgets for the Ohio pork industry, producing over 4.84 million market hogs in Ohio generates over \$750.375 million in feed, labor, equipment, and other production-related expenditures.

• Feed is the largest single expenditure category in pork production. With over 4.84M market hogs produced annually, feed costs for the Ohio industry exceed \$428.365M. Other direct expenses, like energy and transportation, add over \$159.6M, employee compensation totals over \$70.9M, and facility-related expenses add over \$91.3M.

• The direct, indirect, and induced

activity generated by the Ohio pork industry in 2021 supported a total of 16,743 jobs and over \$878.532 million in personal income. Ohio hog farms and pork processors directly employed 7,063 workers and paid over \$382.4 million in total wages. This includes 1,184 full-time-equivalent workers at the farm level and an estimated 5,681 employees in the hog slaughter and processing sectors.

• The purchases of input supplies and services in the pork industry indirectly supported 5,675 jobs and over \$296.4 million in personal earnings for Ohio workers. Beyond this, the induced impacts stemming from employee spending included 4,005 additional jobs and over \$199.6 million in personal income earned. Many of these jobs were within the agriculture and manufacturing industries, as well as industries like trucking, finance, insurance, real estate, trade, and other service sectors.






In 2023, the board of directors

History of the Pork Festival

The Preble County Pork Festival, was born in 1970 when the committee that organized Farm-City Day (the precursor of the Pork Festival) met to discuss ways to improve or redefine the annual event. It was decided that a grand Pork Festival celebrating Preble County's proud porkproducing industry and history was the way to go.

For inspiration, a group of locals visited a pork festival in Tipton, Indiana, and brought back lots of great ideas to get our own pork festival moving in the right direction. The rest is, as they say, history!

Team Tipton included Paul L. Gerstner, County Extension Agent, Agriculture; George Cummings, Conservationist with the Preble Soil and Water Conservation District; Tim H. Miller, Editor of the Register-Herald; Herb Tinstman, Manager of the Federal Land Bank Association of Eaton; first Preble County Pork Festival Chairman and Executive Vice President of the Board of Directors.

Other Executive Committee members included Don Moore, Agnes Voge, Paul Ray, Gene and Janice Bailey, Keith and Betsy Kemp, Bill and Barbara Doran, Robert and Marilyn Jackson, Emerson Voge and Linda Ray.

In 1975, in honor of former Preble County Extension Agent, Wilbur Bruner, Bruner Arena was constructed. Today Bruner Arena is used during the Preble County Fair to house the swine department. During the Pork Festival Bruner Arena is used to house the education aspect of the festival.

Wilbur Bruner, who later became a swine specialist with The Ohio State University cooperative Extension Service), we have been known as The Home of Swine Improvement in America. The early efforts of Bruner and participating local farmers helped bring leaner, higherquality, more nutritious pork to the world.

In 1978, the Festival enclosed the swine barns off the back in of the Bruner Arena. The next year, the festival financed the electrical distribution system for the fairgrounds, and from 1989 to 1991, a sanitary sewer truck line was constructed and installed throughout the fairgrounds. In 1992, a festival storage building was build and another building on the fairground was refurbished for a kitchen facility.

In 1994, an addition was added to provided meeting and office space along with an expanded restroom facilities. The addition was completed in 1995.

Construction began in 2002 on the Expo Building. Once it was finished in 2004, the Preble County Fair housed its beef cattle department in the barn. That same year, the festival began using the building for vendors, along with selling some of the festivals foods.

To date, the festival has donated over \$2 million to Preble County since the festival began.




